Comments

Echovirus (31 types) belongs to the group of Picornaviridae viruses which also includes Coxsackie virus , Rhinovirus, Enteroviruses, Poliovirus & Hepatitis A virus. Echovirus causes asymptomatic infections, upper respiratory infections, congenital & neonatal disease, febrile illness with rash & Meningitis. Positive Echovirus IgG test with increasing titres indicates acute or recent infection.
